This breed grows quick and you do not want to fight a 70lb 6mnth old dog who is scared of something so simple. It just takes a little bit of interaction and teaching to have a better adjusted dog you can bond with that others will also love. Remember to take things slow, don't do too much at one time, short intervals and praise in a calm manner. Keep others safe at all times, especially when interacting with other animals and others who cannot follow directions or are unknowingly helping you.
